## **TODD'S COOLING/HEATING TIPS**

### Ventilation Is the Overlooked Part of HV(entilation)AC

People always ask me what the V in HVAC stands for ... Ventilation. HVAC is the common acronym to describe our business of providing heatingventilating-air conditioning services. Every homeowner pays attention to heating and air conditioning. Often overlooked are the ventilation systems and services we provide.

Previously I've shared articles about energy and money savings derived from air sealing your home - that is, closing off tiny, multiple air leaks that add up to an open bathroom window all year long. Suppose you do that and live in a completely air-tight house. Is that a good thing?

From an energy savings standpoint maybe. However, an air-tight home can be an unhealthy place to live. Most homes are filled with contaminants such as formaldehyde (a component of many home furnishings), volatile organic compounds (from cleaning solvents), mold, mites and other pollutants, maybe even radon. No matter how fastidious a housekeeper you may be, it's not humanly possible to get rid of all of the invisible bugs and chemicals that are present in virtually every home.

Does this mean it's better to live in a drafty house? Not necessarily. There does not have to be a large trade-off between energy efficiency and a healthy indoor environment.

Proper ventilation will help prevent mold growth in your home. This is especially important for basements and crawl spaces. Even if you don't spend much time in these places, enclosed spaces collect moisture and are breeding grounds for mold spores, which will eventually migrate to the living areas of your home. You may not notice any moisture in these areas, but damp air and moldy odors will alert you to its presence.

Home design sometimes makes it impossible to vent to the outside. Our expertise and experience can find solutions where none seem to exist. Leave it up to the professionals to help you find the proper balance between a wasteful HVAC system and a healthy HVAC system.

# **BETHAN'S KITCHEN**



#### **Strawberry Mint Spritzer**

Ingredients: 3 cups sliced strawberries 1/2 cup loosely packed fresh mint 1/2 cup fresh lime juice <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cup water <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cup agave nectar 3 cups chilled club soda Whole strawberries (to garnish)

#### Instructions:

Place first 5 ingredients in a blender; process until smooth. Pour about <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> cup strawberry mixture into 6 glasses. Slowly pour about ½ cup club soda into each glass; gently stir to combine. Garnish with whole berries. For an adult beverage, substitute 1 bottle sparkling wine for the club soda. Pour wine or soda slowly down the edge of the glass to tame the foam.

# **JASON'S PLUMBING TIPS**

### **Indoor Plumbing Became Possible**

The first evidence of a mechanical flushing toilet dates to 1596, invented by a Sir John Harington in England. The following centuries saw various inventor's patent designs for workable toilets. So why did it take until the late 19th Century for indoor plumbing to finally catch on? The main reason is because most people thought moving the toilet indoors a bad idea, and who can blame them? They stunk up the house!



Indoor plumbing did not really come alive until the 1880s. The real hero of modern plumbing is not any of the toilet tinkerers, but a sanitary engineer who came up with the idea of plumbing vents.

Vents enable drains to flow freely by allowing air into drainage systems. This is what venting does to your plumbing system. Without vents indoor plumbing would remain a bad idea.

Plumbing vents also allow sewer gases to be vented safely outdoors. Sewer gases accumulate both from the outside, backing up inside a building from a public sewer or private septic system, and from the inside as toilet waste flows through the building pipes. Plumbing vents typically exit above the roof line of a home or building so they don't leave unpleasant odors and possibly dangerous gases inside the building.

Venting is more than simply punching a bunch of air holes in a draining system. For a plumbing system to work right the vents must be of sufficient size and the right distance from the fixtures served. Over the years sanitation engineers figured out the correct formulas, which are now incorporated into tables and adopted by plumbing codes around the country to guide plumbers when they install plumbing systems in new buildings.

Many people look at plumbing as only about turning wrenches and other relatively simple mechanical tasks. It's a lot more complicated than that. We see some real bungled do-it-yourself projects from people who know little about the importance of venting. Leave it up the plumbing contractors to make sure your venting is installed properly and your home can enjoy indoor plumbing without "outhouse" odors!
